

- The Government has committed an additional £1.4bn to the School Rebuilding Programme, which means 100 rebuilding projects will start in 2025.
- A further £2.1bn is being allocated to maintain and improve school buildings, an increase of £300m compared to last year.
- Colleges will receive a further £300m to invest in the further education estate.
- In Scotland, the Government is progressing with its £2bn Learning Estate Investment Programme (LEIP), which aims to deliver new and redeveloped learning environments for 50,000 pupils across Scotland.
- In Wales's schools, the Government is spending over £1bn a year on capital programmes.
- UK universities spent around £2.5bn on building capital projects in 2023/4, a figure that should be matched in 2025.




